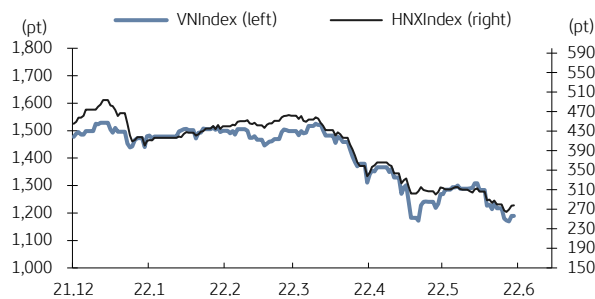

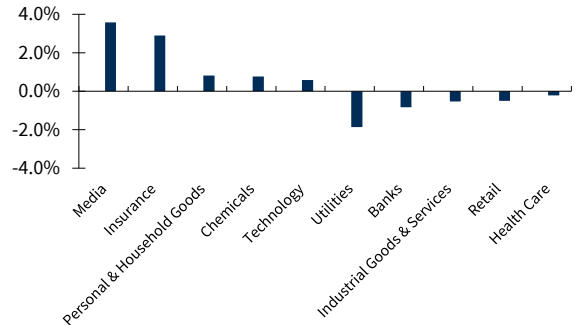
Vietnam's stock market went down amid rising fears about interest rate rises after the State Bank of Vietnam (SBV) withdrew nearly VND50,000 billion through treasury bills over the last three trading sessions. The SBV has just announced the draft amendments to Circular 39 in 2016 in which credit institutions are not allowed to lend deposits or receive transfer of properties formed in the future. It made real estate stocks Development Investment Construction (DIG, -2.8%), Nam Long Group (NLG, -0.8%) decline. Oil and gas stocks PV Technical Services (PVS, -2.8%), PV Drilling & Well Services (PVD, -1.2%) slid as oil prices continued to fall, given worries about US economic recession after US PMI shrank to 52.4 in June (the lowest since July 2020), less than the level of 57 in May. Foreign investors were net sellers, focusing on Novaland (NVL, -1.2%), Hoa Phat Group (HPG, unch), and Mobileworld (MWG, -0.8%).

VN Index & HNX Index



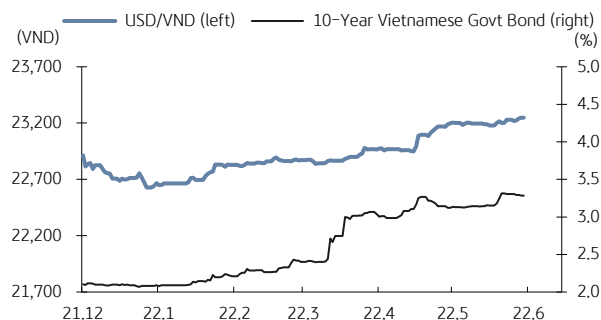

VN Index sector performance



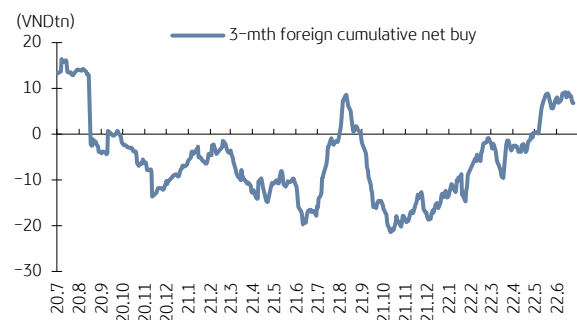

Vietnam - 3-mth cumulative net foreign buy



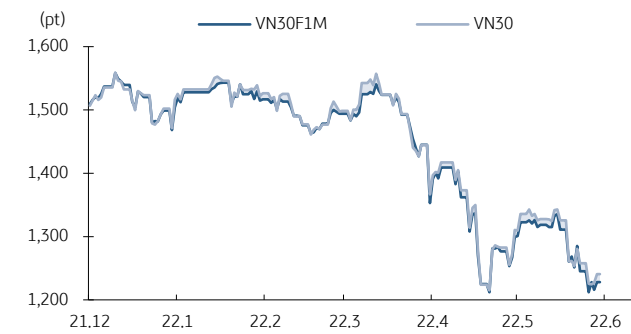

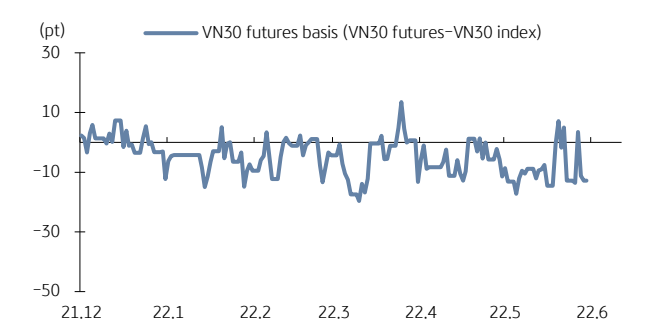
Futures contracts dropped alongside the underlying market. The basis stayed negative around -7.1 bps throughout the session before plummeting in the early afternoon to -10.2 bps and closing at -8.5 bps. Foreign investors were net sellers with a steep fall in market liquidity.

**VN30 futures & VN30 index**



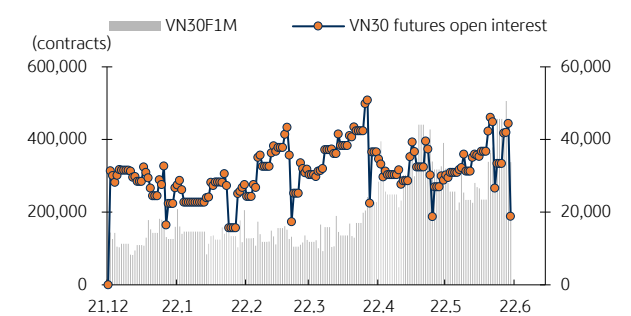

**Front month VN30 futures basis**



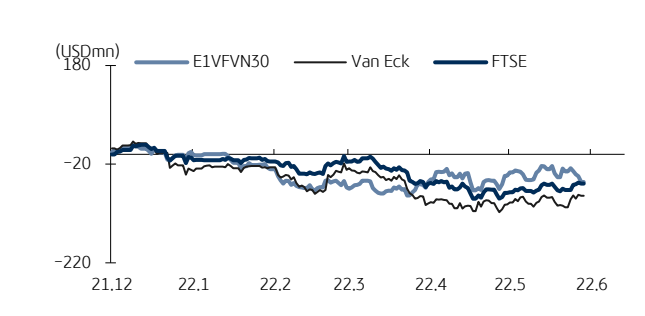

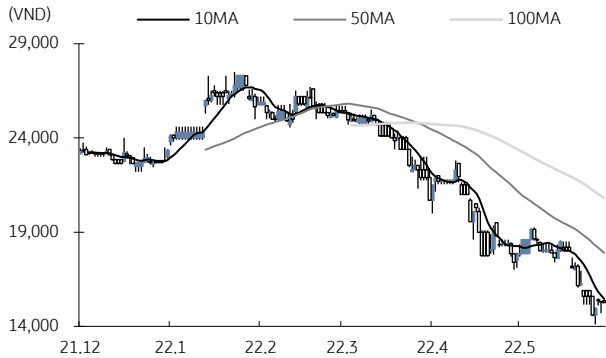
**Vietnam ETFs - 3-mth cumulative net buy**

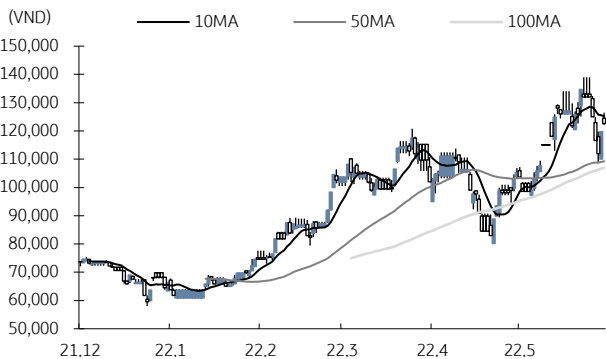
## Vietnam Airlines (HVN)

- HVN closed down 0.33% to VND15,250.
- In 2022, HVN plans to achieve earnings of VND9,335 billion (down 23.5% compared to the previous year's loss) and the parent company's revenue of VND45,252 billion (+2.3x YoY), aiming toward transporting 17 million passengers and 271,200 tons of cargo. The national flag carrier will focus more on restructuring its portfolio, completing the comprehensive restructuring of Pacific Airlines, and divesting from some member businesses.

- DGC closed up 2.34% to VND122,600.
- Duc Giang – Dak Nong Chemical., Ltd, a subsidiary of DGC, was granted the investment registration certificate for the construction of the Duc Giang – Dak Nong fertilizer factory project for NPK fertilizer production with a capacity of 200,000 tons/year and potassium sulfate with a capacity of 4,800 tons/year. The project covers an area of 77,445.9 m<sup>2</sup>, with a total investment capital of VND300 billion.

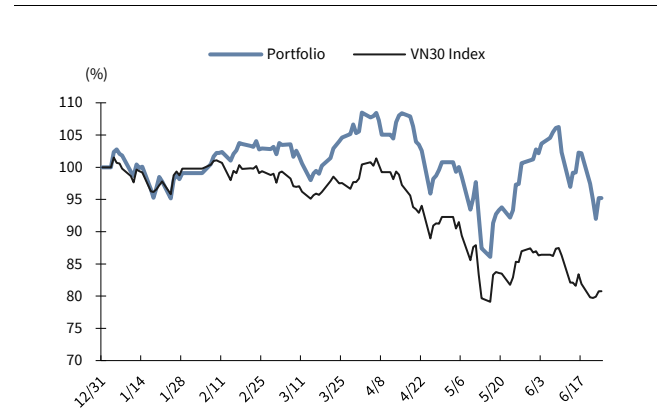
